**WORKSHOP – CLINIC**

As a joint event by the British Turkish Lawyers Association (BTLA) and the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (CI Arb) European Branch, this workshop will be run to provide Turkish lawyers with training and practical input on preparing for and running an arbitration case.

The Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (CI Arb) is the world's leading professional body for promoting the settlement of disputes by arbitration, mediation and other private dispute resolution methods and a not-for-profit, UK registered charity with a global membership of around 12,000 individuals. The European Branch of the CI Arb, chaired by Axel Reeg, is a grouping of members of the Institute, practitioners and academics, who share an interest in arbitration and dispute resolution in Europe.

The team of speakers will be led by Andrew Burr, Barrister, past chairman of the European Branch of the CI Arb, who has extensive experience both as an arbitrator and counsel in arbitrations under English and Swiss law. The panel will consider a number of practical topics, to include the following:

- Basic principles of running an arbitration
- Preparation
- The hearing
- Cross examination
- Discovery or document requests
- Styles of Arbitrators (Adjudicatory v. Inquisitorial)
- Cultural issues
- Witnesses
- What is a QC/barrister/Solicitor.
- Rules of Procedure

Andrew will also be assisted by Av. Bennar Balkaya, a Turkish lawyer, an experienced arbitrator and committee member of the CI Arb European Branch, as well as a committee member and Turkey representative of the ICC YAF, and Jonathan Blythe, an English solicitor, a founder member of the BTLA, an arbitrator and an associate of the CI Arb.

The workshop will consist of two half day sessions. The session in the morning will be for lawyers in private practice and the session in the afternoon which will be specifically tailored for in-house lawyers.
